Septic Conversion Incentive Program

What is this program about?

- LOTT is offering a rebate of 50% of the LOTT connection fee to property owners converting from an existing on-site septic system to the LOTT wastewater system.
- Property owners converting from septic to sewer who meet the criteria for hardship status (Lifeline or other) may qualify for an additional rebate of 25% of the LOTT connection fee.

How does the program work?

- Complete the application form on the reverse of this flyer and submit it to the city Lacey, Olympia, or Tumwater that will be providing utility services to the property that is being converted from septic to sewer.
- City and LOTT staff will review the application, determine rebate eligibility, and send you notification of the rebate amount.
- At the time of payment to the city for charges related to connection to the sewer system, you will receive the rebate as an "instant" rebate off the cost of the LOTT connection fee. You will be responsible for payment of the remaining portion of the LOTT connection fee not covered by the pre-approved rebate, along with other applicable city permit and connection fees.
- This program is in effect from 2019-2024, and subject to available funds.

Why is LOTT offering this incentive program?

These rebates are being provided as an incentive to encourage property owners within LOTT's service area to abandon on-site septic systems and connect to the public sewer system. This benefits LOTT and the community by:

- Helping protect water quality of local groundwater, lakes, streams, and inlets.
- Protecting LOTT's continued ability to discharge to receiving waters.
- Spreading the cost of operating the public sewer system over more ratepayers, helping lower costs for all.
- Gathering data that can help guide future efforts to encourage septic to sewer conversion.

Who should I contact for more information?

Contact the city that will be providing utility services for the property site that is being converted from septic to sewer.

Septic abandonment and sewer connection must follow all applicable rules and regulations as outlined by the local Board of Health, Thurston County, and the city providing sewer service. 		
3.	Application for rebate must be received prior to connection to the public sewer system and prior to payment of charges related to connection to the sewer system.		
4.	. Determination of hardship status is made at the sole discretion of the city – Lacey, Olympia, or Tumwater – providing sewer service the property.		
5.	Rebates are granted as "instant" rebates, which apply only at the time of payment to the city for charges related to connection to the sewer system. The LOTT septic conversion incentive rebate has no cash value. Payment of the LOTT Capacity Development Charge (connection fee) is made by the property owner to the city providing sewer service, along with other applicable permit and connection fees prior to connection of service. At the time of payment, the property owner will be responsible for the amount of the LOTT Capacity Development Charge (CDC) not covered by the pre-approved rebate.
